Geo Textile / Field Leveling – There was discussion about doing something to help support more electric jets at the field. Considerable discussion on geo-textile and bringing in topsoil. Tim will work with Oshkosh club to see if we can visit their location as they have two rolls of geo-textile installed and it is a bit different to fly from. We also needed to set expectations that VAM cannot afford to cover entire field – it would just be a small section of runway. The field will move a bit and we can see how the rolling hills are in the spring.

Fun Fly – June 13, 14, 15 (Fri, Sat, Sun). Events will be on Saturday morning. Food available Friday and Saturday. Cost will be \$5 each day or \$20 for all 3 days with T-Shirt.
